

Public Health Passenger Locator Form for the United Kingdom

Due to prevailing Covid-19 pandemic situation, the UK has implemented border control restrictions for passengers who are arriving to the country. Passenger/s should carry the "Passenger Locator Form" which should be duly filled by the passenger /s up to 48hrs prior to arrival in the UK.



Travel Agents are required to inform the following to the passengers **verbally or in writing, at the time of booking creations and ticket issuance.**

- * Passenger/s must complete an online <u>Passenger Locator Form</u> up to 48hrs prior to arrival in the United Kingdom.
- * Passengers are required to self-isolate for 14days on arrival. Advice to check <u>exempt</u> <u>countries list</u>, immediately before travel, as this list can change at short notice.
- * It is a legal requirement that passengers wear a face mask on public transport in the UK.

Important:

- It is necessary to update PNR with Advance Passenger Information (DOCS/DOCO/DOCA), passenger contact and email under SSR format.
- Refer to Airline circulars & Queues sent by the Airline, and update the PNR with the UK Immigration requirements informed to the passenger/s.

Eg: OSI Remark - SI.YY* free text (add airline remarks)

Vendor Remark - V.AYY* free text (add airline remarks)

- Failure to comply the above country requirement procedures may result in a fine to your passenger/s or ADMs to the respective Travel Agency.
